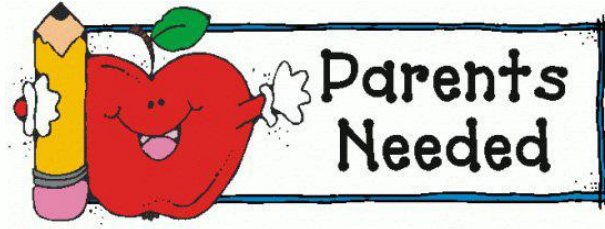
Please remember this evening is an evening for general information. Teachers will not have the time to address individual conversations. Please email the teacher if there are specific concerns.

Dear Parent/ Guardian,

We are excited to start another year at St. Hilary's! Students are invited to participate in the comprehensive music program at the school. **There are some updates this year so please read through carefully.**

1. Choir (Grades 3-8)

The choir meets during the school day before singing at Mass or other events. The choir sings at First Communion Mass, Thanksgiving Family Mass, Christmas Family Mass, Reconciliation, Catholic Schools Week Mass, Fine Arts Festival, Confirmation, and some other school events. Many Masses and events are held in the evening after school during the week. Permission slips will be given to parents to inform and to confirm attendance for each event.

(Make checks payable to St. Hilary School in the note section please say SHS School Choir.)

2. Handbell Ensemble (Grades 6-8)

The Handbell Ensembles perform at the Christmas program and the Fine Arts Festival. All rehearsals are held once or twice a week for a few weeks prior to the performances during the school day. However, the ensembles are not limited to those two performances.

3. Private Lessons – Piano, Ukulele and Drums (Grades 1-8), Voice (Grades 5-8), All Other Instruments (Grades 3-8)

4. Group Lessons (Grades 3-8)

Group lessons can be arranged **ONLY** when there is another child who is similar in age, level, and instrument. All instruments can be used for group lessons except for piano and drums. Group lesson time will be during the day and will be determined after finding the best time for involved students.

5. 'A' Rock Band (Grades 6-8) Wednesday 3:15 - 4:00 PM LIMIT - 6 Students

'A' Rock Band is open to students in grades 6-8 who play guitar, bass guitar, piano, drums or sing. To join the rock band, the student must take private lessons at St. Hilary's.

'A' Rock Band \$20 per 45-minute session

6. 'B' Rock Band (Grades 4-8) Monday 3:15 - 4:00 PM LIMIT - 6 Students

'B' Rock Band is open to students in grades 4-8 who play guitar, bass guitar, piano, drums or sing. To join the rock band, the student must take private lessons at St. Hilary's.

'B' Rock Band \$20 per 45-minute session

7. Mini Orchestra (Grades 4-8) Thursday 3:15 - 4:00 PM LIMIT - 12 Students

Mini Orchestra is open to students in grades 4-8 who play brass, woodwind, string, or percussion instruments. Mini Orchestra will meet every Thursday from 3:15 to 4:00pm. The student must take private lessons at St. Hilary's.

Mini Orchestra \$20 per 45-minute session

Preferably payments are made on a weekly basis. However, if you wish to pay monthly payments must be made the first week of every month. **Payments must be made in advance whether paid weekly or monthly.** When paying monthly, please count the sessions your child will have during that month and pay accordingly. You can send the payment to the school office (marked in an envelope) or to Mr. Jue when picking up your child after lessons. If any lesson is canceled by a parent 12 hours prior to the lesson, the credit will be applied towards the next session or month. **Parents are responsible for payment for lessons that are canceled within 12 hours of the lesson.**

You can even add MyScripWallet to your home screen:

- Google Chrome: open the options menu , then select Add to Home Screen
- Safari: Click  on the bottom of the screen, then Add to Home Screen, then Add



PrestoPay™. PrestoPay is ShopWithScrip's online payment system that you can use for a convenience fee of \$0.15 per order. When you use PrestoPay, your order payment is transferred securely via the electronic debit of your checking or savings account, and your orders will process faster than if you paid by check. You can't link PrestoPay to a credit card as credit cards charge costly fees that would take a portion of earnings away from our organization.

Enrolling in PrestoPay:

- Login to your ShopWithScrip account and click on PrestoPay under Family Functions.
- Enter your checking and general information.
- Two small deposits will be added to your checking account within two days of entering your information to verify your account.
- Enter these two deposits on ShopWithScrip under PrestoPay, and then select a 4-digit PIN.
- Then you're verified, and you'll get an approval code that you need to send to your coordinator!

Safe Environment Requirements for Volunteers

All volunteers who may have any possible contact with children in a parish/school function, or a function that takes place on school or parish property, must have official paperwork filed with the parish office. As a result of the new Harrisburg laws, please read carefully, as the requirements have changed. All volunteers must have all clearances before they begin volunteering – no provisional status.

- ☐ Criminal Record Check – Can be filed online at <https://epatch.state.pa.us/>. This clearance for volunteers is now free. *This must be renewed every five years.*
- ☐ PA Child Abuse History – Can now be filed online at <https://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis/public/home>. Select "individual account." You will have to create an ID and then receive a temporary password, then log back in to create a new password. This clearance is now free for volunteers. *This must be renewed every five years.*
- ☐ Disclosure Statement – Volunteers who have been a PA resident for 10 consecutive years must sign and witness this disclosure (any adult can witness) and return to the parish office. Forms available in the parish office or at: <http://childyouthprotection.org/docs/disclosure%20statement%20volunteers.pdf>
- ☐ Federal Criminal History Report (FBI-Fingerprinting) – Volunteers who have not been a PA resident for 10 consecutive years must also be fingerprinted. Applicant must register prior to going to the fingerprint site at: www.pa.cogentid.com. Complete instructions are available on the website. *This must be renewed every five years until volunteer reaches 10 yr. residency in PA. Unfortunately, this is not free. Once you receive your clearance in the mail, please drop off a copy at the parish office.*

REQUIRED TRAININGS: (Must be completed within 90 days from start date):

- ☐ Protecting God's Children Safe Environment Training – applicant must register prior to the training at www.virtus.org. There is no cost for the training. Create a log-in and password; go to "find session" to register.
 - ☐ Standards of Ministerial Behavior – After the completion of the Safe Environment training, the attendee is asked to sign a form that must be on file at the parish office. The Archdiocese also sends a certificate of completion card to the parish office.
- ☐ Information and Technology Addendum – If you attended the Protecting God's Children Safe Environment Training before July 1, 2011, you will have to review the materials at http://childyouthprotection.org/docs/3.28_Addendum_to_Standards.pdf, then sign the acknowledgement form (attached) and return to the parish office.
- ☐ Mandatory Reporter Training – this is an online training session at <https://learning.childyouthprotection.org/login/index.php>. For all staff and volunteers, the Mandated Reporter Training must be done through the Archdiocesan training on the website (or if you attended an Archdiocesan training session in 2011); any other training will be not be accepted.
 - ☐ Please note that if you began service before December 2011, but did not attend the Mandated Reporter training, you are out of compliance and must complete the online training. Volunteers will need to contact the parish office to learn the level of service they are permitted to provide until the online training has been completed.
